The Caddo Lake Clearinghouse* will host a public meeting for presentations and discussions on the status of Giant Salvinia and a number of other issues affecting Caddo Lake and surrounding lands. The meeting will be held at 6pm on Wednesday, April 26, 2017, at the Community Center in Karnack, Texas.

The Agenda will include:

Status of invasive species, including the reopening of the weevil rearing greenhouses at the wildlife refuge;

New activities on the Caddo Lake National Wildlife Refuge, including the upcoming process for revising the forest management plan and new bird blinds;

Update on the clean-up of groundwater at the refuge on Army lands used for the Longhorn Army Ammunitions Plant;

Latest on the paddlefish reintroduction experiment;

Renovations at the Caddo Lake State Park;

Update on activities at the Caddo Lake Wildlife Management Area; and

The status of the proposal to build an hydroelectric generating facility at the Caddo Lake dam.
